The 2016 year will mark the 9th year of the Asa G. Hilliard/Barbara Sizemore research course that prepares the next generation of scholars to address critical questions related to the success and improvement of educational outcomes of African Americans in the U.S. education system.

This book will explore important issues across multiple sectors of education – sectors represented by Asa G. Hilliard/Barbara Sizemore scholars. A framework for the improvement of outcomes from Asa G. Hilliard and Barbara Sizemore will be used to guide this volume.
